About The Camp

Camp O-AT-KA, founded in 1906 on the shore of Lake Sebago in Maine is a traditional summer residential camp for boys ages 8-16. We seek to develop skills, instill confidence, and build character in a supportive family environment. We welcome campers and staff from a wide variety of backgrounds, and O-AT-KA seeks to bring them together by furthering common interests, promoting a sense of community, achieving progress towards goals, and fostering the development of lifelong friendships.

Camp O-AT-KA offers 30+ activities in athletics, arts, boating, theater, nature, outdoor skills, swimming, etc. and sessions for the campers run from two to seven weeks. The campus is in the town of Sebago and directly on Sebago Lake.

About the Position

Camp O-AT-KA is seeking qualified individuals that will take excellent care of our campers and staff by providing transportation on high traffic and/or special event days at camp.

The camp season is from Sunday, June 16th through Saturday, August 9th and we have occasional need for drivers of our 12 or 15 person vans to transport campers to special events; as well as to and from the Portland and Boston airports on opening and closing days.

Drivers must be 25 years of age or older, have a valid driver's license, pass a complete background check and driver's license check, and be able to lift luggage or equipment. Drivers will be trained by our Facilities Director on operation of the 12 or 15 person van and required to fill out transportation tickets to ensure vehicles are inspected before they leave camp and after they return. Drivers will always have a 2nd adult with them for supervisory assistance. Rate of \$20/ hour; including personal travel time to and from camp; or \$100 per day (whichever is higher).
